Belt Parkway, eastbound to Exit 11 North (Flatbush Ave) make a right turn off Flatbush Avenue to Avenue U (Kings Plaza shopping mall is on the corner). Proceed 4 traffic lights to Mill Ave. and turn right. Proceed 1 block to Strickland Ave., turn right. The El Caribe is located 1/4 mile on the right side of Strickland Ave.

BY CAR WESTBOUND:

Belt Parkway westbound to Exit 11 North (Flatbush Ave) make a right turn off Flatbush Ave. to Avenue U (Kings Plaza shopping mall is on the corner). Proceed 4 traffic lights to Mill Ave. and turn right. Proceed 1 block to Strickland Ave., turn right. The El Caribe is located 1/4 mile on the right side of Strickland Ave.
