

Minutes Traffic & Transportation Committee
Monday, Sept. 13th, 2004

The Traffic & Transportation Committee

Met in quorum on Monday, Sept. 13, 2004, in attendance were Committee Members Robert Cassara, Ron Gross, Brian Kassenbrock, Lawrence Stelter, Timothy Cross & District Manager Josephine Beckman.

At the time the following issues were discussed:

A memorial street naming request for 9-11 World Trade Center victim, Kathleen Hunt Casey, by her sister to name Senator Street & 3rd Ave, "Kathleen Hunt Casey 9-11 Memorial Way." Kathleen Hunt Casey qualifies under the CB 10 guidelines for naming public geographical areas in CB 10 under section D. This request was unanimously approved by the Committee.

A memorial street naming request for 9-11 World Trade Center victim, Thomas Francis Wise, by his parents to name 6th Ave. & 78th Street "Thomas Francis Wise 9-11 Memorial Way." Thomas Francis White qualifies under the CB 10 guidelines for naming public geographical areas in CB 10 under section D. This request was unanimously approved by the Committee.

A memorial street naming request for Terrence Gazzani by his parents to name the southeast corner of 97th Street and 3rd Ave., "Terrence Gazzani 9-11 Memorial Way." Terrence Gazzani qualifies under the CB 10 guidelines for naming public geographical areas in CB 10 under section D. The request was unanimously approved by the Committee.

In attendance were residents' from Dyker Place & 84th St. where new signage near the overpass has eliminated 4 parking spaces. A motion was made to send a letter to DOT requesting a review of this decision, and restoration of the parking spaces. The motion was voted and unanimously approved.

DOT Response to Recent CB10 Requests

88th St. & Battery Ave – all ways stops: turned down by DOT

89th St. & 4th Ave. request for Pedestrian Crosswalk at misaligned intersection/DOT turned down, however, will refurbish the stop line in spring 2005.

"Passenger Cars Only" sign at Ft. Hamilton Exit at Verrazano Bridge/turned down by DOT because trucks use this exit to proceed Northbound, onto 7th Ave.

Missing "Truck Route" Signage Northbound at 7th Ave. 65th St. /agreed to replace sign – work order issued to have sign replaced.

Street light installation on 71st St. & 3rd Ave. was turned down.

No response to:

- 1) Shore Road misaligned center double yellow line

Committee would like to send a letter to MTA requesting data for justification of fare increase for the Express buses.

Committee Member Brian Kassenbrock requested a letter be sent to DOT requesting a study of the light sequences on 3rd Ave. so that traffic flow can be improved.
